

Park Rules

1. Quiet time is from 10:00 p.m. to 7 a.m. Please be respectful of our other campers.
2. There is limited docking so please be respectful of your fellow campers. Jet Skis are only allowed on leased dock slips.
3. No watercraft or trailers in camping sites.
4. Campers are to provide their own garbage cans. When you are leaving, please dump your garbage in the dumpsters that are provided. Dumpsters are located by the boat trailer parking area.
5. No unauthorized motor vehicles are allowed in the park. If there are any questions concerning use, contact the campground host.
6. Air conditioners must be turned off when you leave for an extended period of time.
7. Please remember when parking your campers, each unit is to be either backed in or driven in next to your respective electrical box.
8. Firewood brought into the park must be in 24 inch lengths or less and when burning, must be contained within the fire pit and shall not cause any safety issues. Wood must be free of nails and all other debris. No scrap materials are to be burned in the park. Wood must be stacked neatly within the confines of the lot. Please be aware that fire rings are not to be used as garbage pits.
9. When leaving for an extended period of time, please dump your garbage in the dumpsters that are provided by the boat trailer parking area.
10. All **empty watercraft trailers only** will be parked in the parking area across from the office.
11. Vehicles not registered with the office must register and pay the daily fee.
12. Golf carts/ATVs/4-Wheelers are allowed but are not to be used after 10:00 PM. Golf carts/ATVs/4 wheelers are only to be used to go to boat slips, bathroom or out of park to go on trails. For safety issues, no standing on golf carts and only the required number of people are to be on the golf cart. Those with disabilities or health reasons, please contact the Campground Host for permission to use Golf Cart/ATVs/4-Wheelers after permitted hours.
